There is a significant drive in Lancashire to improve the level of access to information about Apprenticeships and the Apprentice Ambassador network is spearheading this drive.


Ambassadors will attend events to speak about their experiences at schools, youth clubs and careers fairs and meet employers face to face to encourage them to employ Apprentices.
